- 10 Who is speaking during this conversation?
- 11 A. Myself and Kirk Eady.
- 12 Q. If we can go to Page 1, the third line down: "I was
- talking to Oscar this morning."
- Do you see where I am looking?
- 15 A. Yes.
- Q. Who said, "I was talking to Oscar this morning"?
- 17 A. Kirk Eady.
- Q. Do you have an understanding of who Oscar is?
- 19 A. Yes.
- 20 O. Who is Ocar?
- 21 A. Oscar Aviles, the Director of the Hudson County Jail.
- THE COURT: Oscar who?
- THE WITNESS: Aviles.
- THE COURT: Aviles.
- Q. And he is the director of the jail?

- Q. If you could look two lines down, where it says: "He
