On Friday, March 2, 2012, during an Arbitration Hearing, Personnel Officer Anthony Staltari produced CAMPS Forms* (County and Municipal Personnel System – CAMPS) for several Officers. When questioned about discrepancies in the documents, (how they were time stamped 2 weeks prior to being signed, not filed for weeks after being signed, etc.), Staltari clearly stated and reaffirmed, that after he submitted the signed forms to Civil Service he needed to "regenerate" the Forms to suit his needs.

In other words he altered the CAMPS forms, without the officer's knowledge or consent. He calls it "regenerating" - we call it:

2C:21-4. Falsifying or Tampering with Records

a. Except as provided in subsection b. of this section, a person commits a crime of the fourth degree if he falsifies, destroys, removes, conceals any writing or record, or utters any writing or record knowing that it contains a false statement or information, with purpose to deceive or injure anyone or to conceal any wrongdoing.

^{*}CAMPS Forms (County and Municipal Personnel System – CAMPS) are official government forms used to report an employee's status to Civil Service.
